Everyday Wear

Neat fitting Navy Blue, Khaki, Black or Brown pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers or Capri pants with no visible printing or brand logos and worn at the natural waistline. Students in grade second or higher should wear a belt. NO jeans or sweatpants of any color are permitted. NO leggings unless worn under skirts. NO bandanas or headbands with pieces that stand up or hang-off.

Collared, knit button or snap polo-style shirts or polo-style dresses in any color with no visible printing or logo (unless smaller than the size of a quarter). Shirts must be tucked into bottoms. Girls may also wear a buttoned collared blouse in the uniform shirt colors. Boys may wear button-down style collared shirts in the uniform colors.

Cool Weather Wear

Windbreakers, fleece, sweaters or sweatshirt-type jackets or pullovers in solid colors with no visible printing or logo (except the school logo) if worn in the classroom. All other jackets or coats brought into the classroom must be placed in the area designated by the teacher. Long sleeve shirts may be worn under uniform shirts. Girls may wear plain colored tights under their shirts or shorts. NO crazy socks or tights.

Footwear

Closed-toe, rubber-soled shoes (i.e. sneakers) and socks (or tights for girls). Sock/tights colors include White, Light Blue, Navy Blue, or Black. NO boots or slippers of any kind.
